Lynn “Allen” Telle, 93, of Louisiana, Missouri, passed away peacefully on April 27, 2023.

Allen was born October 31, 1929 to the late Henry and Viola (née Bender) Telle in West Kimmswick, Missouri (Imperial, MO). He was baptized at St. John’s Lutheran Church in Arnold, Missouri. He graduated from Crystal City High School. Allen served in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict, receiving several awards. 
