Mrs. Betty June Hooton, 70, of Clarksville, Missouri passed away Saturday, April 11, 2015 at the Pike County Memorial Hospital in Louisiana, Missouri. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, April 15, 2015 at the Clarksville Methodist Church in Clarksville, Missouri. The Rev. Art Moore will officiate. Visitation will be held from 5 to 8 p.m. Tuesday, April 14th at the Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana, Missouri. Burial will be in the Greenwood Cemetery in Clarksville.
