Mrs. Carrie Lee Scott Lanon, 60, of Hannibal, Missouri formerly of Paynesville, Missouri passed away Tuesday, November 24, 2015 at the University Of Missouri Medical Center in Columbia, Missouri after an 18 month battle with pancreatic cancer.

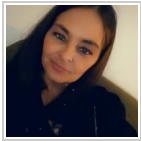
