Funeral services for Mr. Charles Edward Jackson, 95, of Ashland, Missouri formerly of Louisiana, Missouri will be held at 1:00 P.M. Visitation will be held from 11:00 A.M. until time of funeral services at 1:00 P.M. at the church on Saturday, March 22nd. Burial will be in the Riverview Cemetery in Louisiana with Military Honors conducted by members of American Legion Post 370. Mr. Jackson passed away Monday, March 17, 2008 at the Harry S. Truman Veterans Hospital in Columbia, Missouri. He was born September 16, 1912 in Louisiana, Missouri to Roy and Nellie Bly Brown Jackson.

He married Willeta Weir July 7, 1956 in Louisiana, Missouri and she preceded him in death April 13, 2004. He was also preceded in death by a step-son, Earl Salmons who died in 1996 and by one sister, Laveta Morris who died January 21, 1991.

He is survived by 8 granddaughters and 3 grandsons and several great-grandchildren.

He had been employed as a Dry Cleaner for Campbell Cleaners in Louisiana, Missouri for several years. He was later employed at the Louisiana Middle School then at Dundee Cement Co. in Clarksville, Missouri as a janitor until his retirement.

He was a veteran of WW II serving with the U.S. Army in Northern France, Central Europe and the Rhineland Campaigns. He had been awarded 3 Bronze Stars.

He was a member of the Bethel AME Church in Louisiana. A member of American Legion Post 370 and the VFW. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of the Corinthian Braxton Masonic Lodge in Hannibal, Missouri.
