Christina (Tina) Bradley-Tadlock, age 42, of Louisiana, passed away Monday, January 6, 2020 at DePaul Hospital in Bridgeton, MO surrounded by her family and friends.

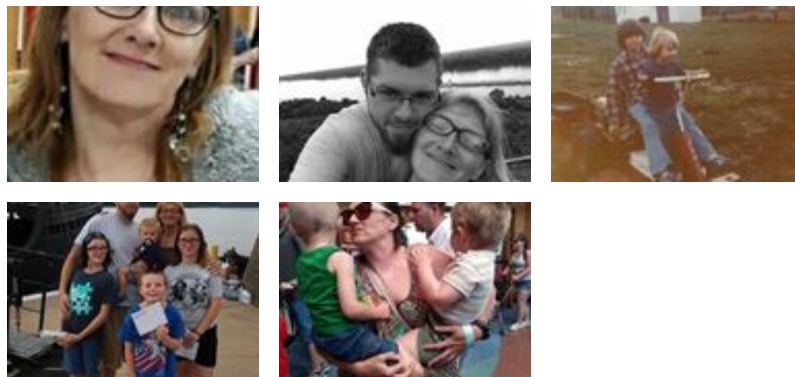

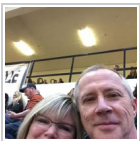
