Mr. Daney Robinson, 86, of Louisiana, Missouri, passed away on Sunday, October 2, 2016 at the St. Joseph Hospital in St. Charles, Missouri. A Celebration of Life service will be held at 11:00am Saturday, October 8, 2016 at Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana, MO. The Rev. Randall Cone will officiate. Visitation will be held from 9:00am until time of service at 11:00am Saturday at the funeral home. Burial will be at the Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Louisiana, MO. American Legion Post #370 will conduct graveside military honors. He retired as an auditor from Union Electric in 1985. During his retirement, he worked part-time at MASH II as a bookkeeper for 25 years.

Daney was a member of the Elks Lodge in Louisiana for 50 years serving as the secretary for 18 years. He was also a member of the American Legion. He was a member of the First Christian Church in Louisiana, MO, serving as Deacon Emeritus.

Daney's greatest pride was his family and extended family. He enjoyed their visits, the many family reunions and loved talking about their accomplishments.

Daney was a proud Marine, and was honored to be a select veteran on the Central Missouri Honor Flight #21 in November 2012. Daney was known to stop by the Marine Recruiting Offices just to visit with fellow Marines.
