Mr. Hurley E. Penn, 100, of Louisiana, Missouri passed away Thursday, October 26, 2017 at the Maple Grove Lodge Nursing Home in Louisiana, MO. Funeral services will be held at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, October 29, 2017 at the Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana, MO. The Rev. Bill Maupin will officiate. Visitation will be held from 1:00 p.m. until time of service at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, October 29th at the funeral home. Burial will be in the Riverview Cemetery in Louisiana.

He was born January 5, 1917 in Louisiana, MO to Carl E. Penn, Sr. and Jessie Stickleman Penn. He married Anna W. Phillips June 1, 1940 in Louisiana, MO and she preceded him in death June 1, 2002.

He is survived by three nieces; Carolyn Smith, Carol Jenkins, and Florence DeWeese all of Louisiana, MO, many great nieces and nephews, and a special friend, Betty Smoot.

He was a lifetime member of the V.F.W. Post in Louisiana, MO. He was a Veteran of the US

Navy during WWII serving on the USS Yorktown Battleship during 10 of its 11 campaigns. He recently had the honor of experiencing the Virtual Honor Flight Tour. He was an avid hunter, fisherman, and mushroom hunter.
