He worked for the City of Louisiana for 40 years as well as beekeeping for 47 years. He was an avid photographer, deer hunter, reader, gardener, and bird watcher. He recorded the purple martins and hummingbirds arrival each spring and it was recorded in the Purple Martin Magazine of Griggsville, Illinois (Purple Martin Capital). He was on the board of the 8 Mile Road District and a member of the Buffalo Township Fire Protection District for 25 years. He worked for the Missouri Department of Conservation as a creel clerk and was also featured in the Missouri Conservation Magazine titled Island Game in 1991. Jim shot 100 and more squirrels a season and recorded it with the conservation by keeping their tails. He was a lifetime member of V.F.W. and American Legion. He was also a
