Our beloved Dullie Joanna Johnson, age 88, left here to meet Jesus on December 14, 2025 at her daughter's home surrounded by her family in Louisiana, MO. She is survived by her dear husband, Edward Allen Johnson, married 68 years, along with her 2 daughters, Jo Annette (Bob) Skidmore of Goddard, KS and Janet Kay (JD) Hutson of Louisiana, MO.

She was Grandma JJ to her precious granddaughters, Natalie Skidmore, Meredith (Jake) Bond, and Caroline Skidmore (Tyler Gudenkauf), great granddaughter Sloane Annette Bond, and Aunt Jo to many nieces and nephews.

Joanna was the youngest of 5 children born September 13, 1937 in Elsberry, MO to Samuel and Velma Phoebus. She is preceded in death by her parents and brothers: Samuel, Gordon, Clifford, and Gerald, and one son in-law JD Hutson.

Joanna graduated from Vandalia High School in 1955. She married Edward Johnson on June 29, 1957 in Pensacola, FL where he was stationed in the US Navy. They returned to Vandalia for 4 years, then she and Ed made Louisiana their home in 1963.

Joanna was very active throughout her lifetime volunteering at the First Baptist Church in Louisiana, MO and attended the Second Baptist Church in Bowling Green, MO. She led Girl Scout troops, was on the organizing board for starting the Head Start children's program and held many positions in SCOPE club, community outreach projects, and she volunteered at the

Louisiana Historical Museum. She and Ed, along with others, started the first Louisiana Colorfest in 1985. Together they were Colorfest Grand Marshalls for one year.

She worked as a bookkeeper at LaCrosse Lumber Co. for 28 years. Joanna, along with Ed, had antique shops and flea market booths for many years.
