Joseph Eugene Henderson, 80, of Louisiana, died April 17, 2015, at University hospital in Columbia, Missouri.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, April 23, at 11:00 a.m. at Collier Funeral Home. The Rev. John Pinkston, pastor of the First United Methodist Church in Bowling Green, and Dr. Earl Wood of Eldon, Missouri, will officiate.
