Mr. John Ben Burse, Sr., 85, of Louisiana, MO, went home on February 9, 2018 at 12:53 P.M. at his home with family. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Saturday, February 17, 2018 at the First Presbyterian Church in Louisiana, MO. The Rev. Lonnie Parker will officiate. Visitation will be held from 11:00 A.M. until time of service at 1:00 P.M. Saturday at the church. Ben was born on June 14, 1932 in Lee County, Arkansas to Tom and Izola Burse. Ben and Everlena was married on January 20, 1951 in Arkansas. They had 12 children. In 1964, They moved to Louisiana, MO where they made a living for their kids. Ben worked at Bob Burns, Wayne B. Smith, Dundee, and Road Construction, then became a self-employed owner of Ben's Salvage Yard for over 40 years.
