Funeral services for Mr. John E. Bibb, 76, of Louisiana, Missouri, will be held at 2:00 P.M. Sunday, August 5th at the Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana, Missouri. The Rev. Mr. Bibb died Thursday, August 2, 2007 at the Lincoln County Nursing and Rehab Center in Troy, Missouri.

He was a member of American Legion Post 349 in Clarksville, Missouri, a lifetime member of the V.F.W., a member of the Louisiana Historical Society, and member of the Friends of the Shortline Railroad. He enjoyed working on antique fire trucks and antique tractors.
