Juliana Rose (Weber) Harvey, 94, entered into eternal peace on Saturday April 9, 2016, at her home in Kansas City, Missouri. Juliana served her family, her community, her country, and her God all the days of her 94 years on this earth.

Judy was born on September 29, 1921, the fourth of six girls to the late Frank and Justina Weber of Passaic, New Jersey. Being orphaned at the age of seven she was then raised by loving Foster Parents Albert and Rose Kruse. She graduated high school in New Jersey followed by her attending nursing school in Orange County, New Jersey. After obtaining her nursing degree she joined the Navy in 1944 where she served her nation during WWII as a Navy nurse at the San Diego Naval Hospital. It was there that she met her husband James Leroy Harvey of Clarksville, MO. They married in San Diego then moved to Louisiana and enjoyed 40 years together before Mr. Harvey's passing in 1987. Her nursing career continued after WWII for an additional 40 years at Pike County Hospital where she ushered in three additional generations of new lives into the world.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband James L. Harvey, Sr.; four sisters, Chris Holovacs, Catherine Schneberger, Emma Weber, Gertrude Sulek, and foster sister, Alberta Kruse-Rodemann.
