Known as Louise throughout her life she was born December 30, 1926 in Louisiana, Missouri to the late Mary Katheryn (Long) and Harvey Newman Boyd. She married Clifford Clifton Jones on August 31, 1947 in Louisiana, Missouri. She is survived by one son Boyd Jones and wife, Susan of Sweet Springs, Missouri and one granddaughter, Kristin Jones of Sweet Springs, Missouri and several cousins.

She attended Louisiana High School and Gem City Business College in Quincy, Illinois. In the early 1950"s she lived in Lexington and Excelsior Springs before returning to Louisiana. She was employed by Stark Brother's Nursery in Louisiana as a Secretary for several years in the early 1960"s and then as a receptionist/secretary at Abel Oil Company in Louisiana from 1968 until her retirement in 1992. Upon retirement she moved to Shelbyville, Missouri then Green City and Sweet Springs to be close to her family. She had lived at Sweet Springs Villa since 2005 due to deteriorating health. As a child Louise was an accomplished Accordion Player. As an adult she

enjoyed gardening and dancing. In later years she enjoyed babysitting her granddaughter, walking and spending time with her family. Throughout her life Louise displayed an outgoing, cheerful and sunny personality which she retained even with several setbacks to her health in the last year and a half.

She was a longtime member of the First Presbyterian Church in Louisiana where she served as an elder and clerk of session.
