Kay Rene Reeve, age 69, of Louisiana, MO, passed away unexpectedly at her residence on Tuesday, May 21, 2024.

Kay was born January 7, 1955 in Amarillo, TX, the daughter of Leroy Martin and Dorothy Foster Capps Savage. One of four siblings, she grew up in Amarillo, TX and attended Tascosa Schools where she graduated with the high school class of 1973. Following graduation, Kay spent two years attending Amarillo College and then transferred to West Texas State University where she completed her bachelors degree in Elementary Education.

Following her graduation from college she entered the teaching workforce in Borger, TX where she taught for 5 years in the school system. It was during this time that she met Tim Reeve in church and one year later they married on July 2, 1982. The couple would remain the next three years in Texas, until they moved to Wynnewood, OK where Kay served as a substitute teacher for two years and gave birth to their first daughter before moving to Oklahoma City and teaching alongside her husband at the Living Word Academy. The family would relocate to Indianapolis, IN due to a new job for Tim for the next seven years where a second daughter was born.

The family would once again move, this time to LaPlace, LA where they would spend the next eighteen years before moving to Louisiana, MO in 2011. While in Missouri, Kay would substitute teach part time while also working other jobs.

Kay had a strong Christian faith and was a faithful devout member of the Church of Christ. She enjoyed bowling at Twin City Bowl in Louisiana and attending her Tuesday Bible Studies with other ladies. She was known to volunteer at the theater and enjoyed singing. Her favorite music was Christian music as well as musicals. She loved to travel to Colorado or anywhere her family was currently living.

Kay will be missed by all that knew and loved her.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00am on Tuesday, May 28, 2024 at the Collier Funeral Homes, Inc in Louisiana. Burial will be in Riverview Cemetery.

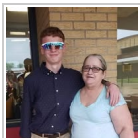
