Frances Leone Cadwallader, 94, of Louisiana, Missouri passed away on June 6, 2008 surrounded by the love of family & friends. Business and Professional Woman's Club was very dear to her heart and she was chosen B & PW

Outstanding Woman of the year in 1989. Louisiana Chamber of Commerce honored her as the Outstanding Citizen of the Year in 1978. A loving mother, grandmother and very busy volunteer, her main goal in life was to be available to others whenever needed.
