He was born November 7, 1913 in Carroll, Iowa to William and Ersa Frisbee Steininger. He married Leta Gay Myers February 16, 1932 in Omaha, Nebraska and she preceded him in death July 29, 2005. He is survived by two sons; Ronald Lloyd Steininger and wife, Mary Sharon of Henderson, Nevada and David J. Steininger and wife, Robin of Harrodsburg, Kentucky, one daughter, Anita Gay Schien and husband, H. Fred of Lake Ozark, Missouri, 14 grandchildren, 16 great grandchildren, 5 great great grandchildren and one sister, Viola Spieker of Manning, Iowa. He was preceded in death by one brother, Wilbur Steininger who died in 1975 and a sister, Bertha Lampe who died in 2010.
