Loren V. Umfleet, 79, of Hannibal, formerly of Louisiana, MO passed away Friday, January 20, 2017 at the Veterans Home in Mexico, MO.

Funeral services will be Friday, January 27, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. at Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana, MO. Pastor Chris Combs, long time family friend, will officiate. Visitation will be from 5 to 8 p.m. Thursday, January 26th at the funeral home. Burial will be at Memorial Gardens Cemetery in rural Louisiana. Loren was born March 27, 1937 in Perryville, MO to Henry R. Umfleet and Omalea Tedder Umfleet.

He graduated from Louisiana High School with the class of 1955, then served in the U. S. Air Force from January 1956 to January 1960 during peace time. He was an Airman 2nd class (E-3) and was awarded the Good Conduct Medal and Air Force Longevity Award.
