Louise Schaffer, 100, of Clarksville, MO, passed away on Sunday, May 26, 2024 at Lynn's Heritage House in Louisiana, MO. Memorial services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, June 1, 2024 at the Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana, MO. The Rev. Jason Mirikitani officiating.
