Lucy Convy Sheppard, 78, of Louisiana, MO, passed away on Thursday, June 12, 2025. 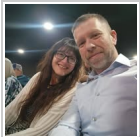

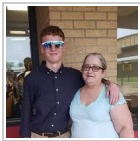
