Mark Eugene Elgin, 54 passed away on Monday, May 21, 2018 at his home in Louisiana, Missouri. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 1p.m. Friday, May 25th at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Louisiana with Fr. Lou Dorn officiating. 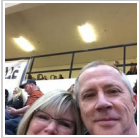
