Miryah Lea Polston, 41 of Louisiana, Missouri, passed away Sunday, Aug. 6, at Pike County Memorial Hospital. Miryah was born Dec. 2, 1981, at the Herman Area District Hospital. Miryah was a member of Christ Centered Church and First Baptist Church of Louisiana.

Miryah married her high-school sweetheart, sharing 24 years together and raising three beautiful children. The city clerk of Louisiana, Miryah was admired for her artwork in town, including a mural of the city seal that she hand-painted at city hall. She was known for being a loving soul, always opening her home to those in need and working hard to better her community. She took pride in her historic home in downtown Louisiana, happily spending hours restoring it and landscaping.

She published her first book in 2014 and went on to co-found Polston House Publishing in 2016, where she signed 10 authors and served as Chief Editor. She was never one to sit idle, choosing to also work as a cleaner for First Baptist Church of Louisiana.

Miryah is survived by her husband Woodrow Polston, daughter Julia Polston, son Alec Polston, mother Felina Pence, father Donald Rzentkowski, brother Moshe "Cal" Schrauth, and sister Aleeza Sinclair.

She was preceded in death by her daughter Angela Polston and her sister Heather Schrauth.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, August 9, 2023 at the First Baptist Church in Louisiana, MO. Rev. Kelly Hardcastle officiating.

Burial will be at the Fairview Cemetery in Frankford, MO. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until time of service Wednesday at the church.
