Pat Radford, age 73, of Louisiana, passed away Monday, February 12, 2018 at the St. Luke's Hospital in Chesterfield.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00am on Saturday, February 17, 2018 at the First Baptist Church in Louisiana with Rev. Terry Cook officiating. Burial will be held in the Fairview Cemetery in Louisiana. Visitation will be held from 4:00pm until 7:30pm on Friday at the Collier Funeral Home in Louisiana.
