



## Robert "Bob" Eugene Findley

March 23, 1931 - January 28, 2022

Robert "Bob" Eugene Findley, age 90 of Louisiana, MO passed away Friday, January 28th 2022. A memorial service will be held at 2:00 P.M. at the Collier Funeral Home, Louisiana, MO on Saturday, February 5th 2022. Visitation will be from 1:00 P.M. until time of service Saturday at the funeral home followed by a graveside service with military honors at the Jordan-Buffalo Cemetery near Louisiana, MO.

Bob was born March 23, 1931 in St. Louis, MO to Edward and Sylvia Findley. He was one of seven siblings, four brothers and two sisters. Bob served in the Army and fought in the Korean War earning a Purple Heart for meritorious performance of duty. Bob ran a successful roofing and sheet metal business from Louisiana for 48 years before retiring.

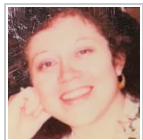

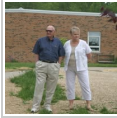
