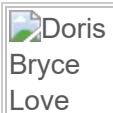
With a heavy heart i send my love and sorrow for the family and friends in this time.

Childhood memories of her living across the street is where my mind goes. I always thought she was the most beautiful and glamorous woman anywhere. I have such sweet memories of her and my mom sitting on the front porch on Saturday nights and the two of them singing. After mom died I sent Tootsie all the "song books" mom kept from those days. Mom wrote the lyrics down from the songs of the times and that is what they used for their singing. I also remember a couple times the two of them putting me and my little brother Chuck in the car and taking us with them to the drive-in to see double or triple feature Elvis movies.

I don't recall a time ever that she did not have a smile on her face and a positive word in any conversation. We recently had a long conversation about our faith and she told me she always prayed for me. She lived her faith and knowing she prayed for me just felt like her prayers may have had more power than some others.

God surely blessed me by allowing me to have such a beautiful soul in my life. I now pray for you that the rawness of your pain eases soon and the hole in your heart fills with joy in your memories.
