Walton Henry Rice, Jr., 73, of Clarksville, Missouri died Saturday, June 30, 2007 at his home near Clarksville, Missouri. Memorial services will be held Tuesday, July 3, 2007 at 2:00 P.M. at the Calumet Presbyterian Church near Clarksville. Dr. Michael Mason will officiate. Mr. Rice was born December 9, 1933 in Dumas, Arkansas to Walton Henry and Musette Lyle Rice. He was married to Sandra Marshall Rice in 1986 in St. Louis, Missouri and she survives. Smith Corporation and then Armco Steel. In 1966 he moved to Clarksville, Missouri as Traffic Manager for Dundee Cement Company. From 1981 to 1984 he was Vice President of Operations and later promoted to Senior VP of Inland Waterways Div., Pott Industries, Inc., St. Louis, MO. After a year of self employment as a consultant he returned to Dundee Cement Company (now Holcim, Inc). He retired from Holcim June 30, 1997 after having been promoted to Senior Vice President. He was an avid hunter, boater and outdoorsman and helped to introduce many young adults to these outdoor
